INVITATION FOR TENDER (IFT)

(Through **GOK e-Procurement Portal** only)

1. The Executive Engineer, Projects Central - 1 Division, invites tenders on behalf of the Hon'ble Chief Commissioner, BBMP, Bengaluru from eligible Tenderers for the construction of works detailed in the table below. The tenderers may submit tenders for works given in the table through e-procurement portal of the Government of Karnataka (viz <https://eproc.karnataka.gov.in>). The Tenderers are advised to note the minimum qualification criteria specified in Clause 3 of the Instructions to Tenderers to qualify for award of the contract.
2. Tender documents may be downloaded from the e-procurement portal of the Government of Karnataka from **07.03.2022**
3. Tenders must be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit specified for the work in the table below. Earnest money deposit will have to be in any one of the forms as specified in the Tender document and shall have to be valid for 90 days beyond the validity of the tender.
4. Tenders must be submitted online through e-procurement portal on or before 16.00 hours on **07.04.2022** and the opening of tenders will be as per the e-procurement portal guidelines.

1. Pre bid meeting will be held on **23.03.2022 at 16.00 hours** in the office of the Chief Engineer (Projects Central) to clarify the issue and to answer questions on any matter that may be raised at that stage as stated in "Instructions to Bidders" of the bidding document.
2. Technical Bids will be opened on the website <https://eproc.karnataka.gov.in> in the office of the Executive Engineer, Projects Central – 1 Division on **08.04.2022 at 16.30 hours**.
3. Aspiring Bidders/Contractors who have not registered in e-procurement should register before participating through the website <https://eproc.karnataka.gov.in>
4. Before submission of online bids, bidders must ensure that scanned copies of all the necessary documents have been attached with bid.
5. All the required information required for Bids must be filled and submit online.

CONDITIONS:

- 1 The Tender Notification along with Blank Tender Form will be accessible in the website of GOK e- Procurement Platform (<http://eproc.karnataka.gov.in>) website.
- 2 Tender documents may be downloaded from Government of Karnataka e-Procurement website <http://eproc.karnataka.gov.in> under login for Contractors. Aspiring Bidders/Contractors who have not registered in e-procurement should register before participating through the website <https://eproc.karnataka.gov.in> or contact e-Procurement Helpdesk at 080 – 22485867 / 22485927.
- 3 The Tender will remain valid for 90 Days from the Date of Opening of Tender.
- 4 The Contractor is not eligible for submission of application for tender form if he has not put the tender after purchase of the tender document continuously for three times.
- 5 The Successful tenderer will have to execute an agreement with BBMP within seven days of receipt of intimation, failing which his tender will be rejected
- 6 The Work shall be commenced with all Men and Material within 3 days from the Date of Work Order, failing to which it would be presumed that the Successful Tenderer is not interested in the Work and Action will be taken to get the Work executed through Alternate Agency at the risk and cost of the Former Tendered.
- 7 The agency should have engaged skilled Labours with necessary equipments/ materials for minimum of last three financial years in similar nature of works.
- 8 As per Govt. Order No.LD 300/LET/2006, Dated: 18.07.2007, 1% of the bill amount will be deducted and remitted to Karnataka State Building & Other Construction Employees Welfare Board.
- 9 The Tenderers are advised to note the minimum qualification criteria specified in clause 3 of the Instructions to Tenderers to qualify for award of the contract (Standard Tender Document – KW-4).
- 10 Any Corrigendum / Modification will be notified in the Notice Board of the Undersigned.
- 11 The BBMP reserves the right to accept/reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons what so ever.

- 12 The Work shall be commenced with all Men and Machinery from the Date of Work Order, failing which it would be presumed that the Successful Tenderer is not interested in the Work and Action will be taken to get the Work executed through Alternate Agency at the risk and cost of the Former Tenderer.
- 13 Within 7 days of receipt of the Letter of Acceptance, the successful Tenderer shall deliver to the Employer a Security Deposit in form of DD/ BG/ FDR drawn in favour of Commissioner, BBMP A/c Executive Engineer, Projects Central – 1 Division, BBMP, Bangalore payable at Bangalore from nationalized / scheduled bank for an amount equivalent to 5% of the Contract price. Otherwise Action will be taken to get the Work executed through Alternate Agency at the risk and cost of the Former Tenderer.
- 14 Further particulars can be had from the office of the Executive Engineer, Projects Central – 1 Division, BBMP during the working days between 10.00 A.M. to 5.30 P.M.
- 15 The bidder should give an undertaking that he/she would abide by the provisions of employees provident fund and shall remit PF of labourers to the respective PF offices or else BBMP have the right to deduct the PF amount from the work bills and remit the same to the respective PF Offices
- 16 The contractor shall quote the rates inclusive of PF as per the applicable rate as issued by the PF department from time to time in respect of employee employed by the contractor as per section 6 of the Act details of contribution which shall be paid the employer towards his share as also deduction from the employee's wages within 15 days from the close of every month with the concerned PF Commissioner and shall satisfy the EPF and MF Act, 1952 and compliance of the same. In default by the contractor, deduction from any amount payable to the contractor under any contract is permissible and such amount paid by the commissioner BBMP can also recovered from the contractor as provided under sec. 421 of or refunded by or BBMP against documentary evidence.
- 17 Additional DD /BG/FDR for Tender difference Amount (if bid is below) should be produced before executing the agreement.
- 18 The Successful bidder shall give an undertaking that he/she would abide by the provisions of employees provident fund act.
- 19 Remittance towards PF shall be commensurate with the labour component of the work involved.
- 20 The bidder shall remit PF of labourers to bidder permanent PF code only.
- 21 The contractor shall quote his rates inclusive of all applicable taxes, levies, duties and cess, building worker welfare cess as per the latest notification of GOK and GOI prevailing on the date NIT.
- 22 The bidder should maintain register of labours deployed and wages paid for the workers and shall produce the documents whenever called for by the competent authority. Remittance towards PF shall be commensurate with the labour component of the work involved.
- 23 ***GST shall be paid to the tendered amount separately.***
