- 1. The Tender Notification along with Blank Tender Form will be accessible in the website of GOK e-Procurement Platform (http://eproc.karnataka.gov.in) website.
- 2. Tender documents may be downloaded from Government of Karnataka e-Procurement website http://eproc.karnataka.gov.in under login for Contractors. Aspiring Bidders / Contractors who have not registered in e-procurement should register before participating through the website https://eproc.karnataka.gov.in or contact e-Procurement Helpdesk at 080 - 25501216 / 25501227
- 3. The Tender will remain valid for 180 Days from the Date of Opening of Tender.
- 4. The Contractor is not eligible for submission of application for tender form if he has not put the tender after purchase of the tender document continuously for three times.
- 5. The Successful tenderer will have to execute an agreement with BBMP with in seven days of receipt of intimation of Letter of Acceptance, failing which his tender will be summarily rejected without giving any further Notice.
- 6. The Contractor / Agency shall intimate the change, if any, in any of the addresses, in advance or maximum within one week of such change along with acknowledgement of noting down of such change in address from the bank, Income tax, Sales Tax authorities etc. Failure to do so liability lies on the Contractor / Agency what so ever.
- 7. The Work shall be commenced with all Men, Material Tools and Plants within 7 days from the Date of Work Order, failing to which it would be presumed that the Successful Tenderer is not interested in the Work and Action will be taken to get the Work executed through Alternate Agency at the risk and cost of the Former Tendered.
- 8. Tenders must be accompanied by Earnest Money Deposit specified for the work in the above Table. Earnest Money Deposit will have to be in any one of the forms as specified in the Tender document and shall have to be valid for 90 days beyond the validity of the
- 9. - 10. As per Govt. Order No: LD 300/LET/2006, Dated: 18.07.2007, 1% of the bill amount will be deducted and remitted to Karnataka State Building & Other Construction Employees Welfare Board.
- 11. The Tenderers are advised to note the minimum qualification criteria specified in clause 3 of the Instructions to Tenderers to qualify for award of the contract (Standard Tender Document - KW-2) also Tenderers are advised to go through the Standard Bid Documents.
- 12. Any Corrigendum / Modification will be notified in the Notice Board of the Undersigned.
- 13. The BBMP reserves the right to accept/reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons what so ever.
- 14. The Tender Accepting Authority shall have the power to accept or to reject any tender without assigning any reason thereof.
- 15. Applicable statutory deduction as per section 51 deducted in the concerned contractor bills, GST will be borne by the Employee.
- 16. The rates quoted in the schedule shall be inclusive of all taxes applicable.
- 17. As per Proceedings of Director, Mines and geology Dated: 25.03.2013 the contractor is mandatory to submit mineral despatch permits from authorised Mines, Otherwise five times the Royalty will be deducted from the contractor bills as per prevailing notification.
- 18. GST will be paid to the tendered amount separately only for 2018-19 schedule of rates and for GST/VAT is included in other than 2018-19 schedule of Rates.
- 19.As per Government Circular No. Cl 81 MMN 2014 Dt: 18.02.2014 &ಗಭೂಇ:ಡಿಸಿಬಿ/ ಕದಗು/ರಾ.ಪ.ಕೋ/2013–14 ದಿನಾಂಕ: 13.03.2014 the contractors are liable to pay royalty in terms of the contract if they are not able to produce the materials purchased document / MDP's from where
- 20. Black Listed Contractors / in Govt. / Quasi Govt. / Boards / BBMP etc., are not eligible to quote, if found such Tenders will be rejected.
- 21. All the participants should produce all the original documents for verification whenever
- 22. The work shall be carried out as per the directions of the BBMP and if necessary in
- coordination with BESCOM, BWSSB, Other Agencies and Engineer in charge of Work.
- 23. No Joint Venture / Consortium is permissible.
- 24. Tender Difference Amount for unbalanced tender quoted separately for individual works should be given in form of DD / FDR/TDR /Bank Guarantee at the time of Agreement

Note: Combined DD / FDR/TDR /Bank Guarante submitted are not accepted and liable for rejection

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- 25. Within 7 days of receipt of the `Letter of Acceptance, the successful Tenderer shall deliv. to the Employer a Security Deposit of Tendered Amount in form of DD /Bank Guarantee drawn in favour of Commissioner, BBMP A/c Executive Engineer, Malleshwaram Division, BBMP, Bangalore payable at Bangalore from nationalized/scheduled bank for an amount equivalent to 3% of the Contract price. Otherwise Action will be taken to get the Work executed through an Alternate Agency at the risk and cost of the Former Tenderers.
- 26. Conditional Tenders will not be entertained and they are summarily rejected.
- 27. Further particulars can be obtained from the office of the Executive Engineer, Malleshwaram Division, and BBMP during the working days between 10.00 A.M. to 5.30 P.M.
- 28. The Construction Debris Generated from Work Shall be dumped in Designated Dumping Yards Only.
- 29. The bidders/Contractors should undertake to follow Labour Laws on, rules notification or any such Govt. Orders/BBMP orders which are in force or which may be come into effect at any time of execution of contract. And also he/she should abide by the Commissioner's Office order no:B12(C1)/PR/20/2014-15 Dt: 08.08.2014.
- 30. In the event of the specified date of tender opening being declared a holiday for the tender inviting authority, the tenders will be opened the next immediate working day.
- 31. As per Commissioner inter Office Note No:e/&eof/1629/18-19 Dated:18-08-2018. the Contractors to Implement/Entrusted the works in 3 shifts round the clock.
- 32. Bidders Should Submit the one set of Hard Copy with spiral Binding of all documents which are uploaded in the e-portal to this office before opening the technical bid. Otherwise their bid will be rejected.
- 33. The Bidder /Contractors should shall not Quote below the minimum labour rates prevailing @ the time of Tender Notification. If so they shall be provide the Rate Analyses for the same. (To be uploaded in e-procurement plat form).
- 34. The Works reserved for SC/ST category relaxation of Tender clauses will be applicable as per Government order No: FD 876 Exp-12/2017, Dated: 10-10-2017.
- 35. Special conditions of contract if any and modification if any will be displayed in office notice board by the under signed and a copy will be uploaded to e-portal from time to time.
- 36. The work shall be executed with all necessary safety measurements in consultation with Police, Traffic and Bescom department for the complete stipulated period mentioned in the document/ estimation.
