## **CIRCULAR**

Subject : Aero-India 2021 : Exemption from RT-PCR Certificate for visitors to –ADVA – reg.

Adverting to the above subject, the RT-PCR negative report was mandatory for general public visiting the ongoing Aero India 2021 from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 5<sup>th</sup> February, 2021 at Yelahanka, Bengaluru.

It is reported that the Air Display Viewing Area (ADVA) is a vast open space with adequate spacing in the seating arrangements and the aero show is being conducted for 2 hours at a stretch. It is also reported that at the venue strict compliance to COVID-19 precautions like compulsory wearing of face mask, face covers, compulsory thermal scanning for fever and screening for symptoms of COVID-19 for visitors at the entry, provision of hand sanitizers etc., is being observed.

Under the circumstances, based on the recommendation of the Technical Advisory Committee, the requirement of compulsory RT-PCR negative report for the visitors to the ADVA for the last 2 days of the event i.e., on 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> February, 2021 is relaxed.
