Minutes of the meeting on Telecom Services held under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary, Government of Karnataka, on 26-06-2015 at 11.30 AM.

Members Present: List enclosed.

At the outset, while welcoming all the officials & representatives of the Telecom Service Providers present in the meeting, the Chief Secretary has said that Telecom services & its infrastructure is of utmost importance for the development of the nation and the Government of Karnataka would extend its fullest support for the development of telecom infrastructure in the State. After detailed discussions, the following decisions were taken:

- 1. Speedy clearance of ROW permissions: All permissions applied for would be cleared within 15 days from the date of application. A new format has already been implemented and will be utilized for all new permissions.
- 2. The Chief Engineer, BBMP (OFC) shall be the nodal officer and single point of contact for all applications shall be submitted by Telecom Service Providers (TSP).
- 3. If any TSP requests, dedicated security for a smooth execution of OFC work the CE (OFC) shall provide it through Police for on field upon payment of applicable charges to BBMP by such TSP. In turn, BBMP shall transfer the said payment to the Police Dept. BBMP shall have to extend its fullest support to the TSP who have been granted ROW permission to execute its work.
- 4. BBMP has to clear all pending applications within 15 days. Operators have to furnish complete details in the new format prescribed for such permissions.
- 5. There should not be any criminal charges for damages, if the same is restored by the concerned within 96 hours of written notice.
- 6. While the CE (OFC) is responsible to get the work executed by the operators and all other ward officer/ field officials are responsible to report any incident to CE (OFC) without taking any action or to stop the work.
- 7. The State of Karnataka is willing to adopt any best practices existing in other State / Cities in the country shall be favourably considered if brought to the notice of the Govt of Karnataka.

- 8. Telecom Service Providers (TSP) may submit the list of govt buildings where they propose to install their telecom infrastructure for consideration.
- 9. The State Government may also explore the possibility of drawing up a suitable policy for towers/telecom infrastructure on Government buildings.
- 10. The Chief Secretary has informed to explore any possibilities of redesigning the DP Boxes installed by TSPs providing landline services so as to ensure minimum obstruction to foot paths.
