

STATUS OF WORK AS ON 30-11-2020

Wind tunnel road Underpass

- The concrete elements required for underpass at Wind tunnel Junction is casted & ready for installation/Stitching.
- Compound wall construction Completed for ISRO.
- Traffic Diversion permission given on 27-08-2018.
- Shifting of BWSSB, BESCOM & KPTCL utilities is completed in LHS and to be taken in RHS.
- Construction of Retaining Wall completed in LHS, service road work is nearing completion.
- Retaining wall at RHS will be started after shifting of BWSSB & BESCOM utilities at RHS.

Suranjandas road Underpass

- The concrete elements required for underpass at Wind tunnel Junction is casted & ready for installation/Stitching.
- Shifting of BWSSB, BESCOM utilities is completed in RHS and to be taken in LHS.
- Construction of Retaining Wall & Service road completed in RHS.
- Retaining wall at RHS will be started after translocate / removal of 32 trees.

Kundalahalli Gate Underpass

- The concrete elements required for underpass at Wind tunnel Junction is casted.
- Shifting of BWSSB, BESCOM utilities is completed in both RHS & LHS.
- Construction of Retaining Wall & 5m wide Service road completed in RHS and LHS towards varthur kodi. Construction of 5m Service road in LHS towards Marathahalli junction is in progress.
- Installation of Precast box elements for central box portion will be commenced after land acquisition, construction of 10m service road & Traffic Diversion permission.

Constraints/Reasons for delay

- Delay due to Land Acquisition.
- Delay due to BWSSB pipe line work.
- Tree cutting pending with forest cell.
- Delay due to 220KV KPTCL cable shifting issue.
- Delay due to additional works amounting to Rs. 39.18 Crores.
- Revised estimate proposal for Rs. 150.50Crores has been submitted to govt on 24-03-2020. Approval awaited.

Wind tunnel road Underpass issues.

- Presence of 220KV KPTCL power cables. Cable & Joint kit is procured from Korea. Request to KPTCL to shift the cables is pending since Oct-2019 and the work is completed in February-2020.
- ISRO authorities insisting for 6.0m service road for their trailer movement.
- Meeting under Chairmanship of Hon Commissioner with both NAL & ISRO is held on 03.01.2020. NAL has agreed to hand over additional land of 390 Sq m for service road. NAL requested for issuing TDR which is under process. ISRO has agreed to handover the land after the necessary approvals from Head office. The work is resumed from 25-02-2020

Suranjandas road Underpass issues

- Total of 32 trees has to be removed by forest cell after inspection of Committee formed as per the direction of Hon. High Court.
- Tree committee inspected the trees & suggested to translocate 7 out of 32 trees. HAL agreed to permit translocation of trees in their land; accordingly action is in process from DCF, BBMP.
- After translocation of trees, DCF has to take action to remove the 25 trees.

Kundalahalli Gate Underpass issues

- As per the instructions of Hon'ble Chief Minister during city rounds on 08.9.2019 to increase the width of service road from 5.00m to 10.00m, Rate negotiation meeting under the Chairmanship of Sp. Commissioner (Pr) with Land Owners is held on 03.01.2020, but owners didn't agree Rate of (Present Guidance Value x 1.633) but are demanding 3 times the Guidance value.
- 2nd meeting with owners held on 24th Feb-2020 & rate of 2 times the guidance the value is decided. 27 owners have given the acceptance letters. Land acquisition is under process at the office of JC Mahadevapura and DC (LAQ & TDR).
- BMTC is advised to reroute the buses from Kundalahalli junction to Whitefield main road.
- Ward committee agreed to traffic closure and diversion upto 3 months for installation of precast box elements for central covered portion of underpass.
