OFFICE ORDER

The MSW generated in BBMP limits has to be processed at various processing plants. The earlier orders in this direction showing the destinations for solid waste from different zones has to be modified in view of enhancement of the intake capacity of new plants & also to reduce the mixed waste being transported. In this direction a detailed meeting was conducted with the zonal Joint Commissioners, Chief Engineers, Superintending Engineers & other officers on 01.02.2016. As per the information collated from zonal authorities & decision taken with regard to generation/ allocation of destinations, a comprehensive order for destination of different types of wastes of zones was envisaged. Hence as decided, in suppression of previous order dated 07-12-2015 pertaining to MSW Destinations, the destination for various types of MSW from various zones are indicated as below:


As mentioned above, by 1st of March mixed waste to MSGP should be brought down to 695 TPD & TF to be brought down to 600 TPD.

The allocation is made applicable till 31st March with the conditions mentioned in Remarks column. Following conditions are to be followed further-

1. The Zonal Joint Commissioners/CEs have to strive hard for 100% segregation as early as possible and take all necessary measures to ensure above.

2. Zonal Commissioners/CEs should ensure disposal of Wet, Dry & Mixed waste in the said destinations. The vehicles should be fully loaded ensuring non spillage of leachate.
3. Zonal Commissioners/CEs should issue vehicle number wise orders as per above allocation informing the concerned plant operators in advance to make necessary arrangements and appoint nodal officers for each destinations by the concerned zonal JC managing the plant and send a copy to the Head Office.
4. Contractors/Transport Agency needs to be informed properly not to deviate from above routing and follow the rules strictly and failing which they would be heavily penalised for any deviation as well as unloading anywhere else.
5. Daily report on unloading destination-wise should be submitted by the concerned CEs/SEs of each zone to HO. During the festival season, proper care has to be taken to ensure non-acumulation of garbage on the streets by ensuring complete loading of the garbage transport vehicles.
6. Zonal Commissioners/CEs must plan ward wise and transport vehicle wise proper routing and disposal of vehicles to ensure smooth flow and lifting of waste.
7. Zonal Commissssioners/CEs can bring above plan to the notice of Elected representatives as well as general public.

Above directions are to be strictly followed. Any deviation will attract disciplinary action. Allocation comes into effect from 13-02-2016. By this time all the Zonal Joint Commissioners should allocate the ward wise vehicles to the plants as per the capacities allotted and ensure that orders reach the concerned plant operators and all the concerned.
